### Delta Rho Annual Projects

-  Award a chapter member a \$500 scholarship for further education

-  Co-sponsor a Christmas Bazaar (silent auction) with Gamma Sigma chapter to raise money for our grant-in-aid scholarship
-  Prepare and distribute a teacher basket of school supplies for all new Lee County teachers at the “Beginning Teacher Orientation”
-  Sponsor an annual "Beginning Life with Books" spelling bee to raise money to provide a book for each child born at Central Carolina Hospital
-  Award 8 literacy grants of \$200 each to Lee County teachers for innovative, classroom-based literacy projects in reading and mathematics
-  Contribute money at each meeting for the various NC DKG and Delta Kappa Gamma International funds
