It's that time of year to reflect on what Delta Rho accomplished in 2023: February nominated and voted on new members (and inducted 4 new members in May); March "Beginning Life with Books" Spelling Bee celebrated 23 years of raising funds to purchase Goodnight Moon to give to newborn babies born at CCH, had 34 teams (7 new teams) participating, provided funds for 8 literacy grants; July/August-provided teacher supply bags to all new beginning teachers in LCS and distributed them at the New Teacher Orientation meeting; Christmas Bazaar-raised January/February 2024

more than \$1,000 for our grant-in-aid scholarship form the silent auction.

We had some firsts this year. For the first time, our recipient of our Recruitment grant-in-aid came from CCCC's University Transfer Program (Associate in Arts -Teacher Preparation and Associate in Science -Teacher Preparation). We had our Christmas Bazaar in Sanford at Jonesboro United Methodist church.


DKG News Available Now
