### **Convention Project Supports Local Food Bank**

Food insecurity is growing and a local food bank that is a member of Feeding America is the 2022 NC DKG Convention project.



The Mountain Area Nutritional Needs Alliance (MANNA), a private, 501(c) (3) non-profit organization, works to end food

insecurity for students and families in Western North Carolina (WNC).

Every \$1 donated to MANNA helps provide four meals for people across WNC. Chapters and/or members are invited to support the convention project with donations. Checks and money orders may be written to MANNA FoodBank with reference to the 2022 NC DKG Convention Project. Bring checks to the convention or mail to MANNA FoodBank at 627 Swannanoa River Road, Asheville, NC 28805. #### **Convention Registration is Open**

The first step for convention attendance is registration! The <u>link for registering</u> is now active on the NC DKG website and can be found on the <u>convention page</u> or through the link in the "New on the Website" box.

Registration via a Google form is available by check or credit card until April 10. Early bird registration for Beginning Teachers and Collegiate members is \$25 and is \$35 for all other members. One day registration is \$20. Any registrations after April 10 should be made online with a credit card and will include a \$10 increase in fees and a \$4.50 processing fee. Checks should be postmarked by April 1 to avoid the increase of fees, made payable to NC DKG Convention, and mailed to Leslie Black, Convention Treasurer, 4715 Little Mountain Road, Catawba, NC 28609. Contact <u>Leslie</u> with questions regarding payment.

Meal options are available for Saturday's continental breakfast, boxed lunch, and banquet meal, and for Sunday brunch as part of the birthday celebration. Banquet and brunch meal tickets are not available for purchase after April 10.

The registration form also provides an opportunity for donating to Headquarters as part of "Pass the House" and contains information about donating to the convention project MANNA FoodBank.

Everyone must register, including award recipients, presenters, guests, and those who are volunteering during the convention. Submit one registration form per person. Refunds will not be issued if you do not attend the event.
