

Board Hires Membership Consultant

Among the items listed in the recent DKG News article summarizing the actions by the DKG Administrative Board in November was approval of the hiring of Avenue M as a membership consultant. The item included: "With a steady decrease in membership, the Board recommends that membership data be evaluated deeply to appropriately address the loss in membership, decline in leadership applications, and increase in



chapter dissolutions. Analysis of data, identification of trends, and accumulation of diverse types of data from extensive sources could lead to the development of strategies to assist the Society, state organizations, and chapters in engaging members and strengthening growth."
