Beth Winstead will lead NC DKG for the 2021-2023 biennium. Beth was elected President during Saturday's vote by registered members attending the 2021 NC DKG Virtual Convention. Elected to serve with Beth were Hilda Parlér as First Vice President, Tammy Cullom as Second Vice President, and Patrice (Patty) Higgins as Secretary. The installation of officers took place virtually on Sunday afternoon and was led by Immediate Past President Connie Savell. NC DKG President Dr. Teresa H. Cowan kicked off the convention on Friday night, April 23, 2021, via Zoom and Facebook Live. Highlights of the convention included the presentation of the Founders Award to Dr. Mandy K. Cohen, Secretary of the North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services, who has led NC's COVID-19 response; the presentation of the Chapter Achievement, Scholarship, and Beginning Teacher Awards; and guest speakers Trish Woodley, International Membership Director, and Watha Kollmeyer from the convention project Knickers for New Life.

Quick Convention Highlights

Friday Opening General Meeting: Watha Kollmeyer, founder and director of Knickers for New Life, shared about our convention project. At the Birthday Celebration meeting, Tobey Worthington, First Vice President, led a Founders activity on Seeds of GROWth. The Founders Award was presented to Dr. Mandy K. Cohen, Secretary of the NC Department of Health and Human Services.
